**Articles of Incorporation**

**Tau Gamma Gamma Chapter of Fort Bragg**  
  
(a non-profit corporation)

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of eighteen years more, acting as Incorporators for the purpose of creating a Nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of North Carolina, as contained in pursuant to section 55 A-2-02 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the undersigned corporation does hereby submit these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation.

1. The name of the Corporation is: Tau Gamma Gamma Chapter of Fort Bragg
2. The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.
3. The purpose of which the corporation organized are:
  - a) To stimulate the attainment of ideal and ambitions of its members.
  - b) To supported deserving high school seniors by defraying the cost of college by providing scholarships.
  - c) To provide mentoring programs at local schools.
  - d) To cooperated with schools where its chapters may be located.
  - e) To conduct seminars, workshops, and other educational events and activities.
  - f) To carry on scientific research for the purpose of aiding a community or geographic area..
  - g) To enhance the quality of community life.
  - h) To do any and all lawful acts and things, and to engage in any and all lawful activities, either directly or indirectly, and either alone or in conjunction with others, which may be necessary, useful, suitable or proper for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering, or attainment of any or all of the purposes for which the corporation shall exercise only such powers as are in furtherance of the exempt purposes of organization set forth in section ( c ) (3) of the Internal Revenue code in 1986, and the regulations there under as same now exists.
  - i) To receive and administer funds exclusively fro small business, scientific, educational, and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code of 1986, as from time to time amended, and not for pecuniary profit or financial gain.

4. The corporation shall have members.
5. The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The method of election of the directors shall be as determined by the bylaws of the corporation.
6. Said organization is organized exclusively for the charitable, and educational, purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
7. No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustee, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code of 1986, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Service Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
8. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or the such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, educational, scientific or literary purposes as shall at the time qualify as exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the code as the Board of Directors shall determine, or to federal, state, or local governments to be used exclusively for public purposes. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, such as the court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes, or to such governments for such purposes


